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## Abstract submission guidelines

- Word count: maximum 300 words. This count does not include the title and subheadings of the abstract, authors' names, affiliations, or keywords.
- Text: prepared in Microsoft Word, font Times New Roman, font size 12 pt.
- Manuscript structure (for meta-analyses, original and review articles): Introduction with aim, Materials and Methods, Results, Conclusion.
- Manuscript structure (for case reports): Introduction, Case Presentation, Key Messages for Clinical Practice.
- For other types of manuscripts, the abstract does not require a specific structure.
- Keywords: three to six keywords or phrases. Keywords should be separated by semicolons. When selecting keywords, use Medical Subject Headings – MeSH (<http://www.nlm.nih.gov/mesh>)(<http://www.nlm.nih.gov/mesh>).

### Additional instructions

- Format A4, all four margins 25 mm.
- Line spacing 1.5, alignment justified. Use the tools in the toolbar to check alignment.
- If special characters (symbols) are used in the text, use a font from the "Symbol" font package.
- If something is conventionally written in italics, it should be presented as such (e.g. gene names).
- The use of company names, pharmaceutical companies, or proprietary drug names is not permitted. Only generic drug names should be used.
- Submission of the abstract implies that all authors agree with the final version of the abstract and its publication in the Congress Abstract book.
